



Where to eat?

The Cornish Pantry

This is a self service cafeteria that offers a selection of hot and cold meals, plus sandwiches, cakes and drinks. There is a large indoor dining area as well as tables outside in the main square.

The Longships Bar and Restaurant

Open to non-residents with stunning views over the Atlantic Ocean to the Longships Lighthouse and beyond. Bar meals are served from 12noon, the restaurant is open from 7pm and offers a menu of traditional dishes cooked from local ingredients, booking is essential.

The Bakehouse*

The Bakehouse has 2 kiosks which serve take-away food out onto the main square, and an inside servery area, which is open at peak times only, selling hot take-away food. The 2 kiosks are open in the busy months selling Pasties, ice-creams and snacks, plus hot and cold drinks.

Kelly's Ice-Cream Shop*

Real Cornish scooped Ice-cream is sold here, plus ice lollies and, hot and cold drinks, There is a small seating area inside.

Directions and walks

The actual Land's End point, i.e. the most south westerly point of Britain, is at the front of the First and Last House.

The Land's End Signpost is situated to the front of Penwith House. Operated independently by Courtwood of Penzance since the 1950s, there is a charge to stand under the post with your town and mileage displayed.

To access the coastal paths go straight through the main complex to the front of Penwith House. Turn left to go in front of the hotel and down to Greeb Farm, here you can pick up the coastal path towards Porthcurno. Turn right at Penwith House and head to the First and Last House to pick up the coastal path to Sennen Cove.
